1. Cape Sounio Grecotel Boutique Resort, Sounio

££ | SPA | POOL | Best for sunsets

At the southernmost tip of the fashionable Athens Riviera, the majestic fifth-century BC Temple of Poseidon is a famous sailors' landmark high on the cliffs of Cape Sounio. This Grecotel resort is located just across a cove from the cape, amid the pines in a nature reserve. The buildings were designed to echo the Classical architecture of the temple — but with something an ancient Greek never had: luxurious swim-up rooms. There's a curling sandy beach plus a spa, a kid's club and the chance to sea kayak, sail or — if you're very fit — to go coasteering. Cape Sounio's sunsets are famous; the full moons unforgettable.
